- Results from Tests/Diagnostic tools – Need to be sent to the physician for them to follow up on.
- Testing will be ordered by the physician and will be reported back to the ordering physician
- This program can help our local doctors accept more Medicare and Medicaid because this extends the outpatient practice – Dr. Werner
- Home Checks
 - Fall Prevention and have the paramedic understand the use of assist devices – Link with PT and Kelly Lombardi – Understand the need for the equipment and how to have the physician order the equipment
 - Safety issues with seniors CO and Fire Alarms
 - Child Sleeping, Car Seat Checks, Gates, Infant care items used, beds, (prevention committee)
- Wound Care – Checklists and understanding of the competency – keep the assessments objective – Second tier limited for first year or two
 - Healthy Post Surgical – Most Doctors want to see
 - Chronic wound care – decubitis
- Diabetic Care and education – what are the gaps after the patient leaves
- Post Discharge – medications reconcile the list and help the post discharge linkage from hospital, home and attending physician
 - Refrigerator lists
- Create a Medication reconciliation list
- Create a Fall Prevention Check list
- We won't do anything unless the physician orders it...the physician order sheet
- Blood Redraws
- Mental Health – Medication compliance and how do solve this at a community level This may not be a big issue for Community Paramedic because there will always be a referring physician and they should be aware of this. If there is an issue then the CP will refer the problem back to the PCP
 - Understanding the resources in the county
- Oxygen – CPAP, BiPap, understanding of how it works, fitting, mechanical
 - O2 Sat checks
 - Ambulatory check O2 stat
 - Smoker
- Urinary Catheter Insertion
- Long Term – Wound Care, Lactation, IV Antibiotics, Synergist (Immunization),
